
Comments from the Commander

I enjoyed the "Calversion" Vol. No. 41. and the stories about Makin. I was aboard at that time. Capt. Stark says that the objective "was secured without too much trouble." I do recall that when we were maneuvering at night, (to avoid Japanese submarines), the Liscombe Bay, a small carrier, was torpedoed off the Calvert's quarter. Lost aboard the carrier was Admiral Mullinix who, I believe, was the brother of Captain Mullinix?

Afterward, when Makin was secured, the Admiral in charge sent a message "Makin Taken." (I still have the original). Later, in the forties, I dined with Admiral Samuel Eliot Morrison who was also at Makin. When I showed him the wire with "Makin Taken" he laughed and said that if the originator knew the pronunciation of "Makin" he could have sent a much better wire! Admiral Morrison said that the correct pronunciation was "Muckin!"

Also, the article about "Crossing the Line, November 15, 1943." (I was made a "Shellback" at that time I <u>still have</u> photos of that celebration! ...if I could find them)? I remember that later that month, when we also crossed the 180th meridian, we had <u>two</u> Thanksgivings! (We were fed well for the first one, but not for the second one).

It was shortly after when we had secured Kwajelein, (Operation Galvanic), that I was commissioned "at sea."

Capt. Harry Boger Stark USN(ret)

USN (Ret) passed away at the San signments on two major fleet com-Diego Hospice on July 15 after an mands. extended illness. He was a Pearl Harbor survivor on the USS West was spent primarily in Washingeran.

He was born in 1914 in Boston, Mass., the son of Colonel and Mrs. Harry W. Stark, U.S. Army. Harry decided to torego the army life, and after a year at William and Mary College he entered the U.S. Naval Academy, graduating in 1936. Upon graduation he immediately commenced his naval career at sea. His sea assignments were in destroyers, amphib ships and battleships. His duties included ship command, a destroyer

Captain Stark's shore duty Virginia and a World War II vet- ton D.C. in the Bureau of Naval Personnel and on the staff of the joint chief of staff. He retired from the Navy in 1966 as the Commanding Officer, Naval Station. Pearl Harbor. For his wartime service he was awarded two Bronze Stars and a Navy unit commendation in addition to area awards.

After he retired, Captain and Mrs. Stark resided in Coronado where he attended San Diego State University to obtain his masters degree in education. He taught in the San Diego City School District until his second retirement in 1976.



- 2. Restrictions on release of information. Release of information is subject to restrictions unposed by the military services consistent with Department of Defense regulations and the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) and the Privacy Act of 1974. The service member (either pass or present) or the member's legal guardian has access to almost any information contained in that member's own record. Others requesting information from military personnel/health records must have the release authorization in Section III of this form signed by the member of legal guardian, but if the appropriate signature cannot be obtained, only limited types of information can be provided. If the former member is deceased, surviving next of kin may, under certain curvivingations, be enabled to greater access to a deceased vierning records than a member of the public. The next of kin may be any of the following: unremarned surviving spouse, fainer, mother, son, daughter, sister, or brother. Employers and others needing proof of military service are expected to accept the information shown on documents usued by the military service department at the time a service member is separated.
- 3. Where reply may be sent. The reply may be sent to the memoer or any other audress designated by the member or other authorized requester.
- 4. Charges for service. There is no charge for most services provided to memoers or their surviving next of kin. A nominal fee is charged for certain types of service. In most instances service fees cannot be determined to advance. If your request involves a service fee, you will be notified as soon as that determination is made.
